

# HONOR OR THANK A VETERAN WITH AN ENGRAVING AT EAGLE PARK VETERANS MEMORIAL



The City is continuing to accept applications for engravings on the Veterans Memorial adjacent to the 1924 Mountain View Union High School flagpole at Eagle Park, 650 Franklin Street. The park was built on the former school grounds in 1989, and also contains a plaque honoring the school's students killed in World War II.

To give the memorial more significance, the City will be installing 17 additional black, granite panels. Each new panel will be placed above an existing panel and installed on an ongoing basis. The existing curved wall dividing the flagpole area from the rest of the park has been enhanced with five military service emblems and granite panels engraved with names of veterans. Two park benches have been installed for the comfort of those viewing the memorial or attending ceremonies. One of the benches is still available to be dedicated for the amount of \$5,000.

Any individual, school, or fraternal organization may purchase an engraving on the 17 remaining black, granite panels to honor or thank a U. S. Veteran. For purposes of this memorial, Veterans are those who are still serving or have served honorably, domestically, overseas, in peace or combat, regardless of length of service, whether living or deceased in the U.S. Armed Forces, Reserves, or National Guard. It also includes Merchant Marines who served from 1941 to 1946.

The cost for the 3" x 5" three-line engraving is \$178. Panels will be installed on an ongoing basis until the remaining 17 are completed with 16 engravings each. A gold star will be added to designate veterans killed in action.

## Engraving Application Form (electronic applications recommended)

Any individual, school, or non-profit organization may buy an engraving to honor or thank a U. S. Veteran who served honorably. Veterans are those who served or are still serving honorably, domestically or overseas, in peace or combat, regardless of length of service, whether living or deceased. Panels will be installed on an ongoing basis until the remaining 17 granite panels are complete with 16 engravings each.

Each 3" x 5" engraving consists of one to three lines, with a maximum of 17 characters per line (including spaces and periods). Engravings will be on black granite panels mounted on the columns of the curved wall at Eagle Park. A gold star may be added to designate veterans killed in action. To support the memorial, the cost for the three-line engraving is \$178. Payment options include check, money order or credit cards (If paying by credit card, please request an authorization form).
